Vendor Fee

Black Owned Business Vendor Fee \$25. All others are \$75. This fee scale is designed to promote equity and Black-owned businesses. We welcome most vendors, but we do ask community-based nonprofits to come up with meaningful ways you intend to contribute to the community.

Vendor Details

This is an outdoor event. We provide all vendors with a 10x10 space. All vendors must bring their own tables. **There is no electrical service available.** Food vendors - if you are using propane grills, you must have a permit from the fire department and your own fire extinguisher. Apply for that permit [here](#).

Space to set up - all booths ready by 11:30 am and all vehicles must be removed from the park before 12 pm. Each food vendor must supply a [temporary food establishment permit](#) and submit a copy of their current Allergen Awareness and ServeSafe Certificates with their application. (If the vendor is from outside of Pittsfield, a copy of their city/town permit for Food Service.) **There is no electrical service available. We have to use the only source for our bouncy house.**

Accessibility

This space is handicap accessible and flat level. There will be loud music played throughout the day in an outdoor setting.
